Our fundraiser delivery/pick up date will be December 9th. You may pick up from 11am to 5pm. Drive to the back of the school. Watch out for the band!!

KISD Progress Show – Friday/Sat. December 11/12th

The Katy ISD Progress Show will be held Friday and Saturday, Dec. 11th and 12th at the NEW Show Facility. Exhibitors will compete for awards and placings in showmanship and livestock evaluation among FFA members from all KISD Schools. The show will begin Friday with goats at 5pm followed by lambs. Saturday swine will start at 8am followed by steers.

- All students must wear a mask
- Tokens will be handed out for showmanship call back
- Students must refrain from shaking hands with judge
- Judge will not ask students questions nor talk to students individually during or after show or selecting showmanship
- Goats and Lambs may walk over to show pavilion. As soon as class is over only the students called back for showmanship or place in the top two of each class will remain. Everyone else must exit and go back to barns
- Swine will begin loading to go back to barns as soon as your students are finished showing
- Steers may walk over or trailer over for the show

Advisors will provide details to exhibitors before the event to prepare for the show. We look forward to all of our exhibitors working hard to prepare, supporting each other during the show, and learning how to improve their projects and showmanship.

Winter Showdown – Saturday, Jan. 9th at the Show Facility

In preparation for the upcoming district shows, the Cinco Ranch FFA will be hosting the Winter Showdown at the Show Facility. This is an opportunity for students to work with their livestock project, receive showmanship feedback, and become

comfortable in the show ring within a chapter setting. **All Cinco Ranch FFA members are encouraged to attend as this meeting serves as our chapter Christmas party!** The show will feature a clinic for each show species as well as showmanship contests. Families are welcome to watch the event and encouraged to attend. Students participating will need to wear jeans (no holes) and closed toe shoes with their Showdown t-shirt. Entry forms are available in the Ag hallway for exhibitors to pick up and return. Entry dues will be \$20 cash per entry (includes a show t-shirt) and due Monday, Dec. 14th by noon to Ms. Kacal.
